

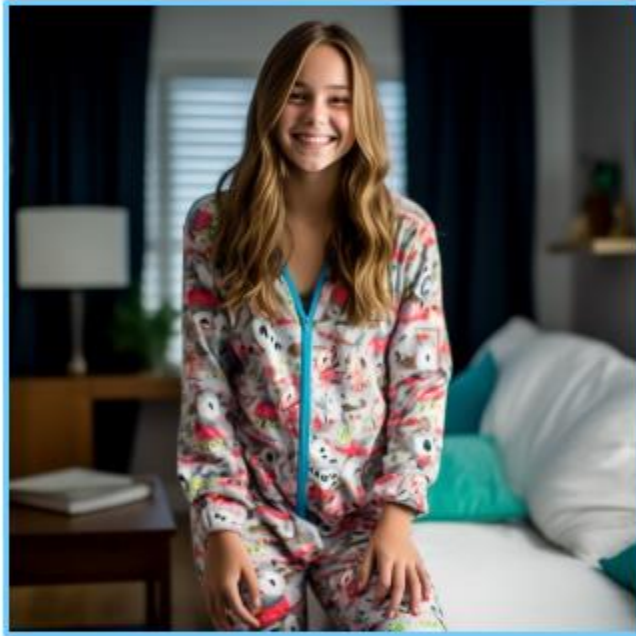

**by**



to say when something will be completed

She will finish cleaning **by** two o'clock.

**until**

8 a.m.  
↓  
4 p.m.

to say up to what time something happens

Marc is in school **until** 4 p.m.

**for**



to say how long something happens

My mother works **for** 8 hours every day.

**during**



to say that something happens at a time period

We light fireworks **during** New Year.
