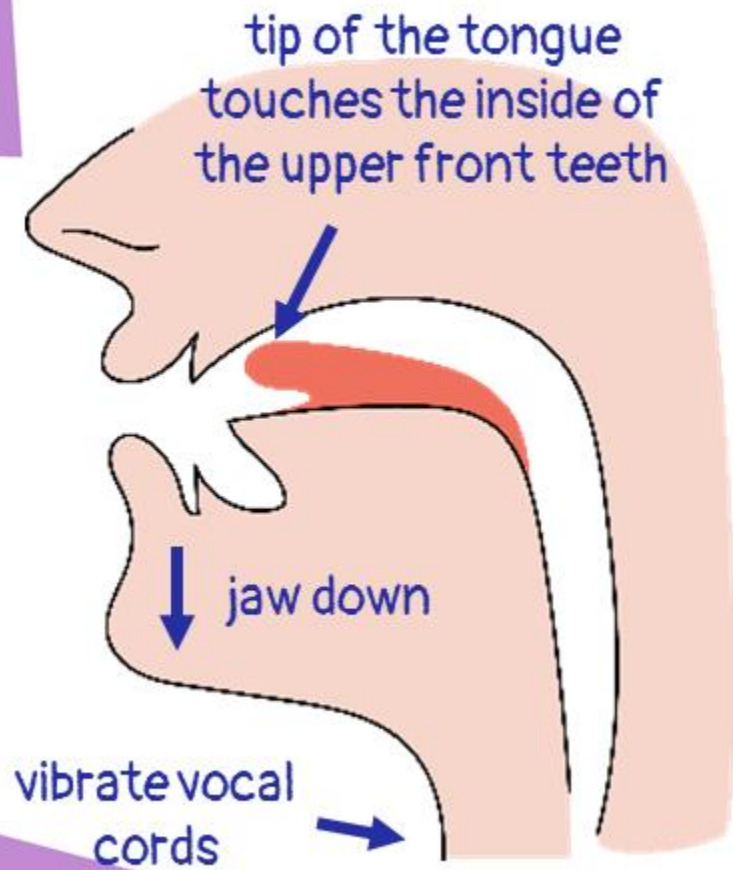
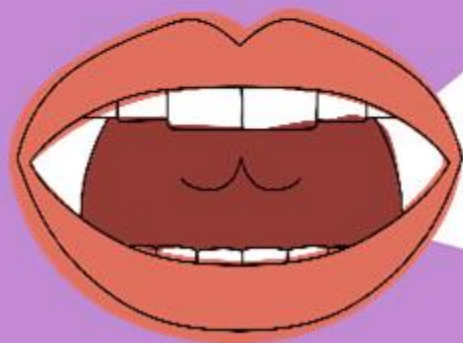

## Light and Dark

The **light l** happens when 'l' is followed by a vowel. The tongue touches the top of the mouth and flaps back down. Say **lap!**

The **dark l** happens when 'l' is after a vowel sound. Here, hold the tongue on top of the mouth. Say **pull!**
