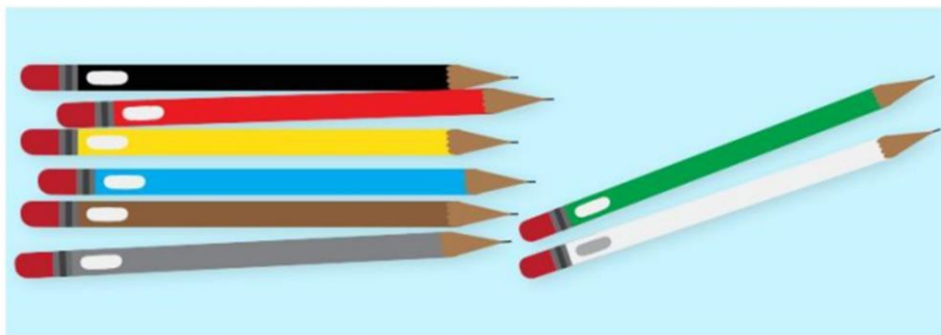

/ɛ/ - The tongue tip is held in the middle and at the front of the mouth; usually nearer the bottom teeth than the top teeth; should not touch the teeth; and lips are not spread.

/æ/ - The tongue tip is held low and at the front of the mouth. It is quite close to the bottom teeth; does not usually touch the bottom teeth; lips are not spread; and jaw drops slightly.
