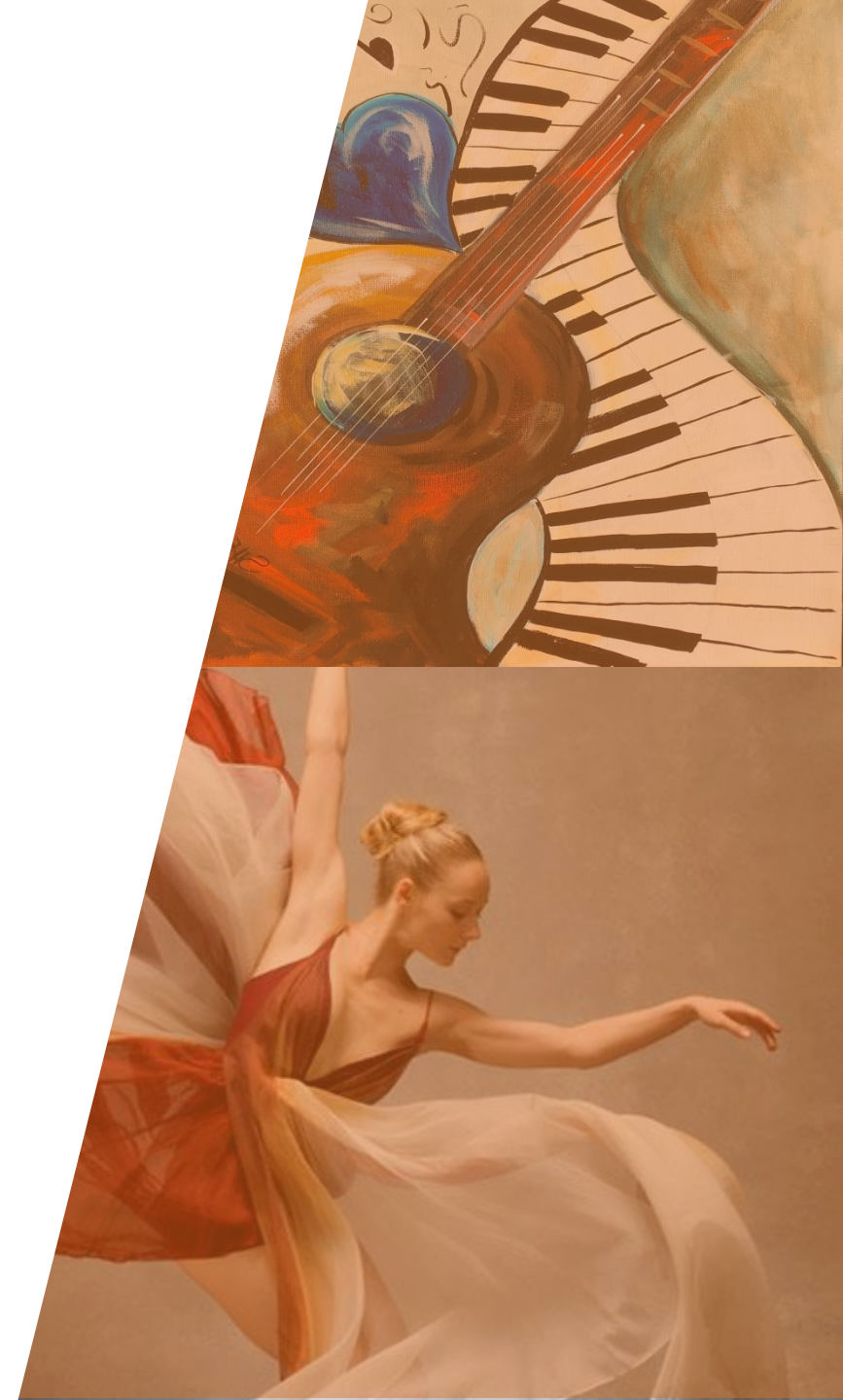

Linking Words

Linking words are used to connect ideas together. They have different uses.

because

as

since

so

therefore

to

in order to

1 Knights wore armor. It protected them in battles.

→ Knights wore armor **because** it protected them in battles.

2 Leo practiced every day. He won the first prize.

→ Leo practiced every day **so** he won the first prize.

Linking Words Linking words have different uses.

1 **Because, as, and since** are used to give a reason for something.

The paintings are precious **because/as/since** they are so old.

linking word *reason*

2 **To and in order to** are used to explain why we do something.

! **To** is always followed by the **infinitive**.

We study **(in order) to** learn new things.

linking word *infinitive* *purpose*

I finished my homework **so** I can now play.

linking word *result*

! **So** is usually in the middle of a sentence.

I finished my homework. **Therefore,** I can now play.

linking word *result*

! **Therefore** is at the beginning of a new sentence.

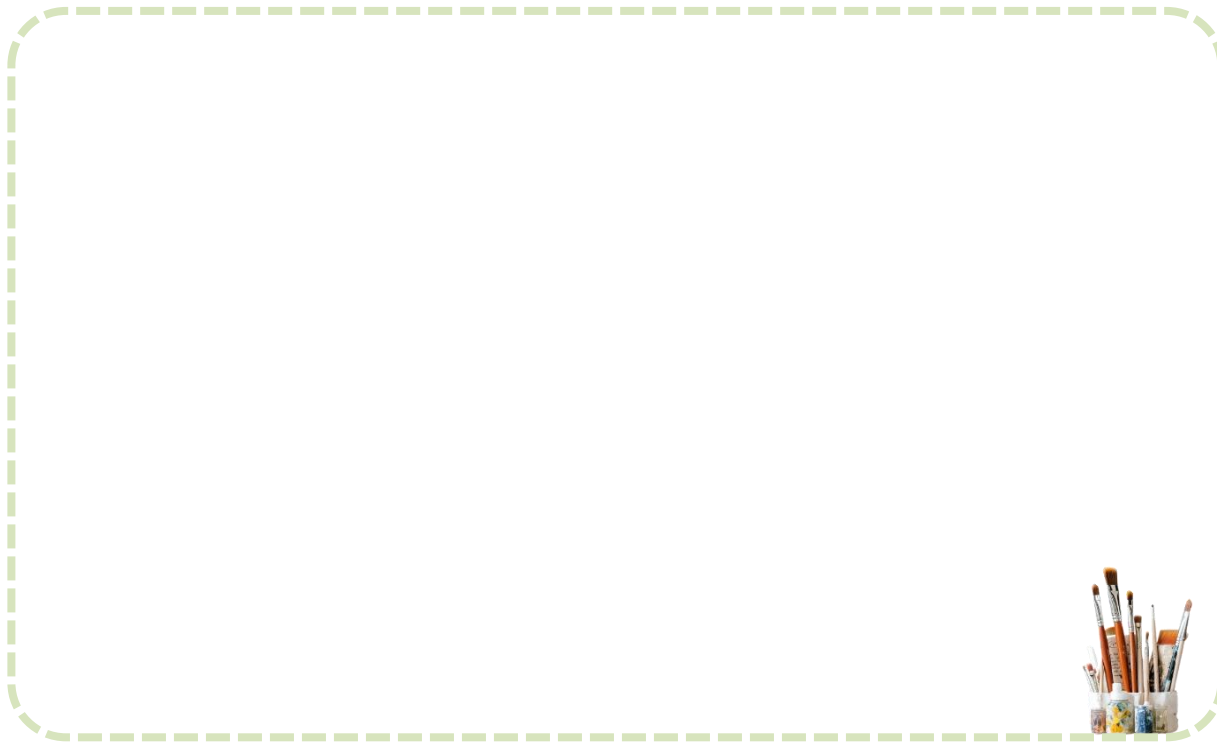

ex. We wear coats **because/ as/ since** it is cold outside.

2 **To and in order to** are used to explain **why we do something**.

ex. John practice singing **(in order) to** become a better singer.

3 **So and therefore** are used to give the **result** of something.

ex. The sun is shining **so** we can go outside.

The sun is shining. **Therefore,** we can go outside.
