A response email is a written reply to a previous email or message, <u>providing a direct answer</u> <u>or response</u>.


When writing a response email, you can follow the structure on the right.

- **2** Respond to the first question / Key Point 1
- **8** Respond to the second question / Key Point 2
- Respond to the third question / Key Point 3
- **5** End of the email


