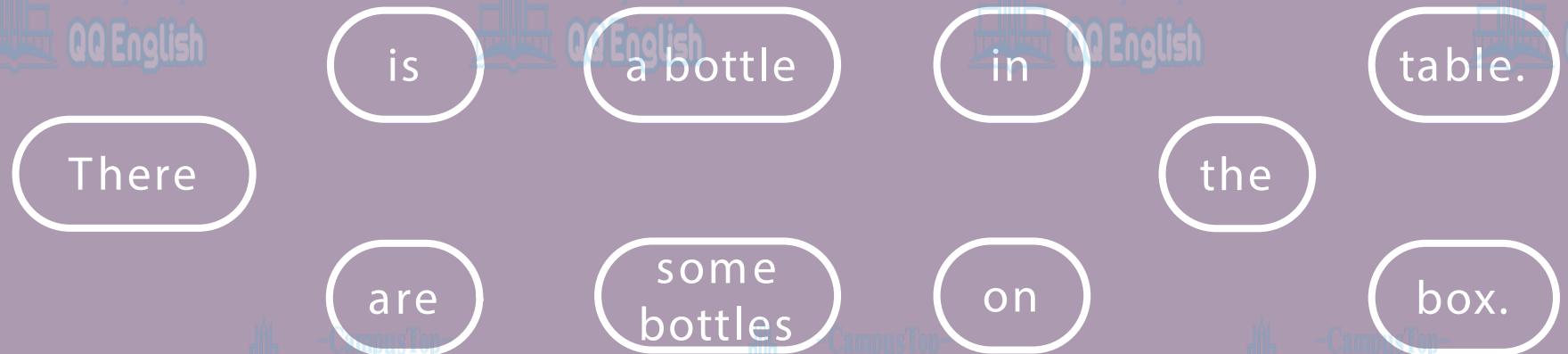
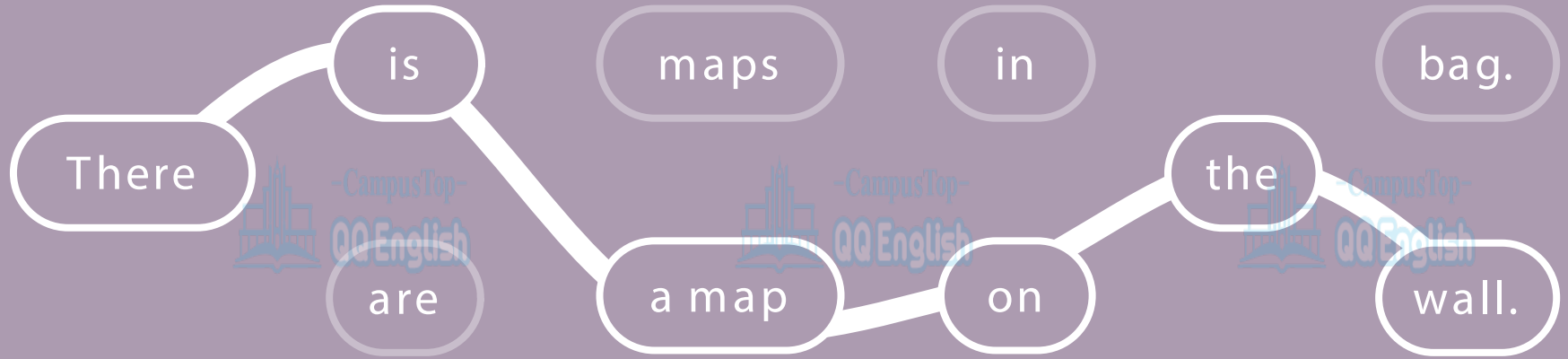

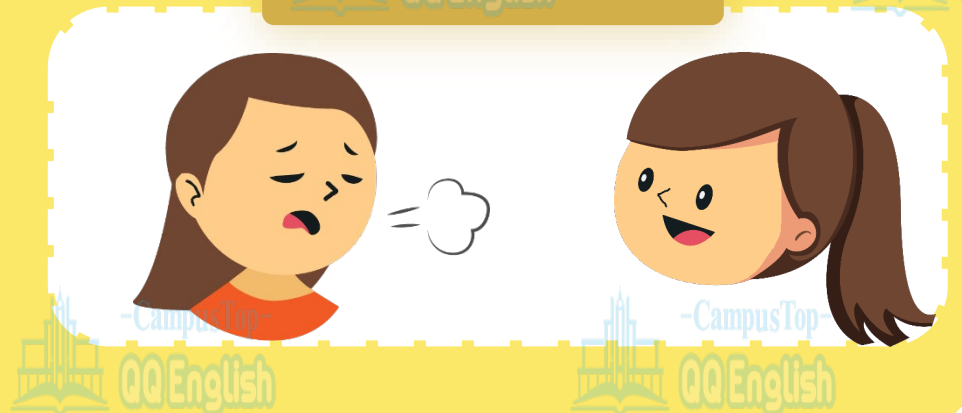

(matter/ problem)

is tired.

We use *What's the matter* to ask about the **matter /problem**.

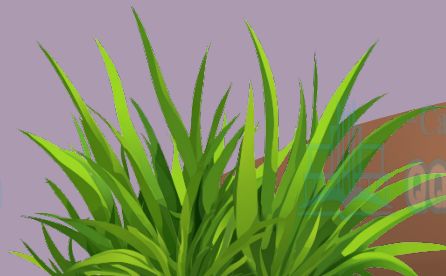
