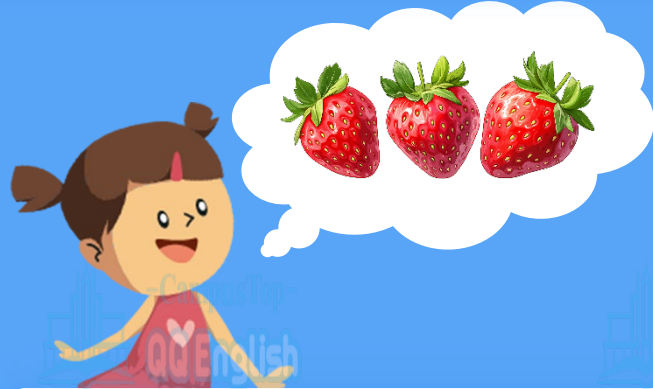

Arrows indicate connections between words in adjacent cells:

- Orange arrow from 'can' (row 1, col 4) to 'I' (row 1, col 5)
- Orange arrow from 'I' (row 1, col 5) to 'fish' (row 4, col 5)
- Yellow arrow from 'can' (row 2, col 1) to 'I' (row 2, col 2)
- Yellow arrow from 'I' (row 2, col 2) to 'some' (row 3, col 4)
- Yellow arrow from 'some' (row 3, col 4) to 'biscuits' (row 2, col 4)
- Green arrow from 'yes' (row 2, col 1) to 'can' (row 4, col 1)
- Blue arrow from 'no' (row 4, col 1) to 'you' (row 4, col 2)
- Blue arrow from 'you' (row 4, col 2) to 'can't' (row 4, col 3)

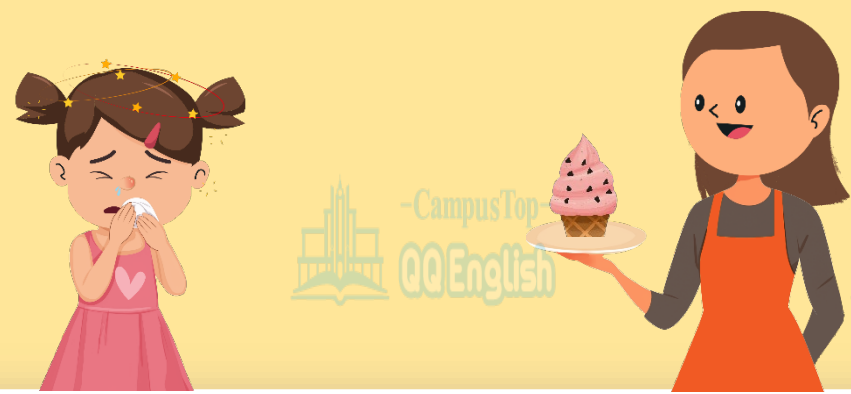
