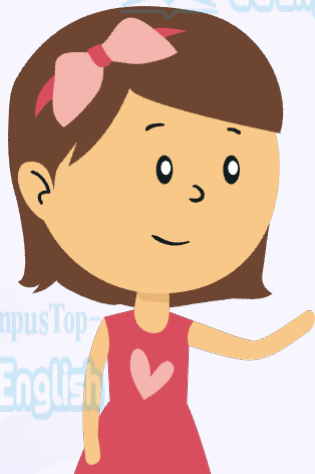

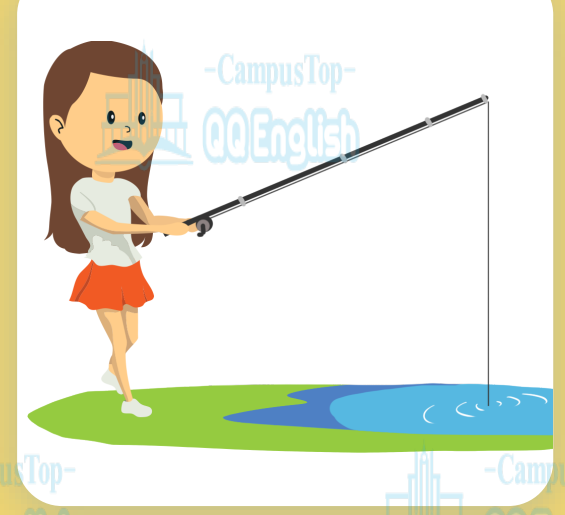

# Present the Grammar

Look and read.

What does he do for fun?

I go hiking.

He rows a boat.





He **rows** a boat.

a boat.

**He/ She/ It + verb + “-s”**

e.g. He **rows** a boat.

She **plays** a game.

Tom **rides** a bicycle.

**He/ She/ It + verb + “-es”**

verbs ending with “*sh*”, “*ch*” or “*o*”:

e.g. -sh: She **fishes** in the river.

-ch: He **watches** birds.

-o: She **goes** hiking.

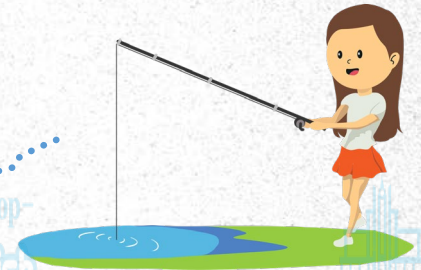

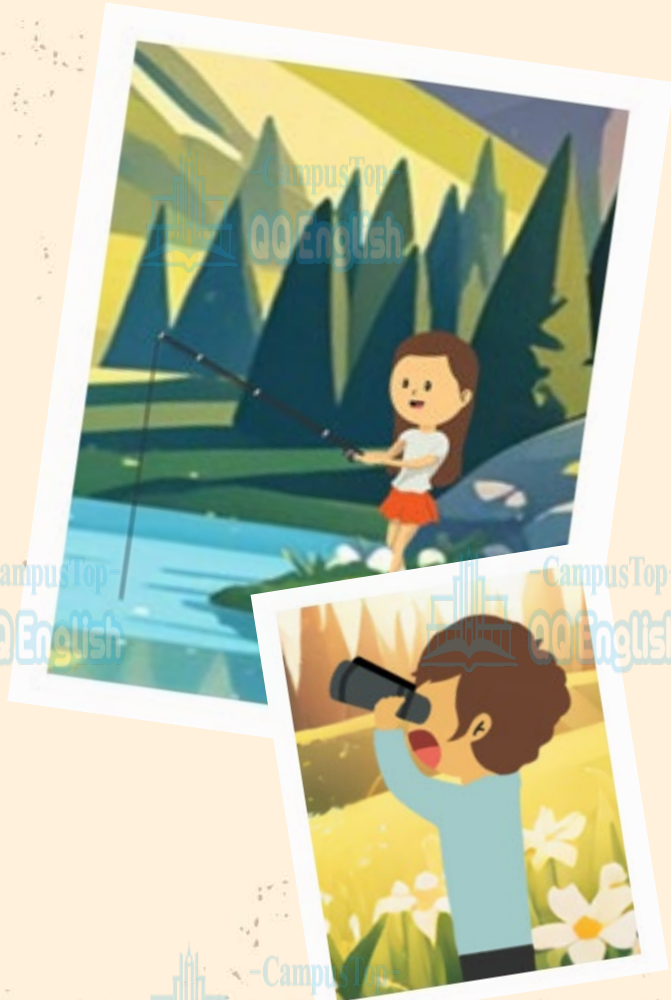
