
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












Present the Grammar

Present simple: subject-verb agreement



You row

He rows

She rows

We row

They row

a boat.

He rows a boat.



He/ She/ It + verb + "-s"

e.g. He rows a boat.

She plays a game.

Tom rides a bicycle.

He/ She/ It + verb + "-es"

verbs ending with "sh", "ch" or "o":

e.g. -sh: She fishes in the river.

-ch: He watches birds.

-o: She goes hiking.
