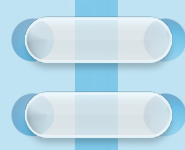

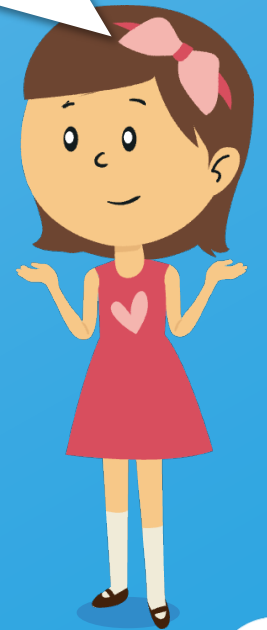

Comparatives

adj. + er

(for most of the adjectives)

tall

taller



Allen is taller.

More examples

smart – smarter

small – smaller

sweet – sweeter

adj. + r

(for adjectives
ending in the letter “e”)

large

larger



The blue T-shirt is larger.

More examples

nice – nicer

polite – politer

close – closer

double the

ending letter + er

(for adjectives ending in a heavy syllable)

fat

fatter



The white cat is fatter.

More examples

hot – hotter

thin – thinner

big – bigger

y → i + er

(for some adjectives
ending in the letter “y”)

healthy

healthier



Salad is healthier.

More examples

heavy – heavier

busy – busier

happy – happier

A + am/ is/ are + **comparative** + **than** + **B** .

e.g. Allen is **taller than** Alice.

Yes-No

am/ is/ are + **A** + **comparative** + **than** + **B** ?
