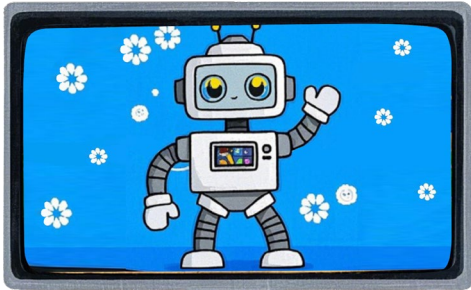


Cartoons are **more interesting than** TV news.

Talk shows are interesting,
too. But they're **different from** cartoons.

more + adj.

(for most adjectives with more than three syllables)



Cartoons are **more interesting** than TV news.

interesting

(four syllables: in-te-res-ting)

more interesting

More examples

exciting – **more** exciting

beautiful – **more** beautiful

careful – **more** careful

meaningful – **more** meaningful

Present the Grammar

Pattern: different from

different from

A + am/ is/ are + **different from** + **B**

(= A and B are different.)

e.g. Talk shows **are different from** cartoons.

(= Talk shows and cartoons are different.)

More examples

My language **is different from** yours.

The weather in New York **is different from** the weather in London.
