



more + adj.

(for most adjectives with more than three syllables)



Cartoons are more interesting than TV news.

interesting

(four syllables: in-te-res-ting)

more interesting

More examples

exciting – more exciting

beautiful – more beautiful

careful – more careful

meaningful – more meaningful

different from

(= A and B are different.)

e.g. Talk shows are different from cartoons.

(= Talk shows and cartoons are different.)

More examples

My language is different from yours.

The weather in New York is different from the weather in London.













