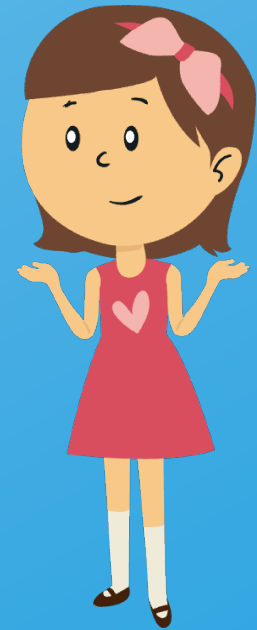

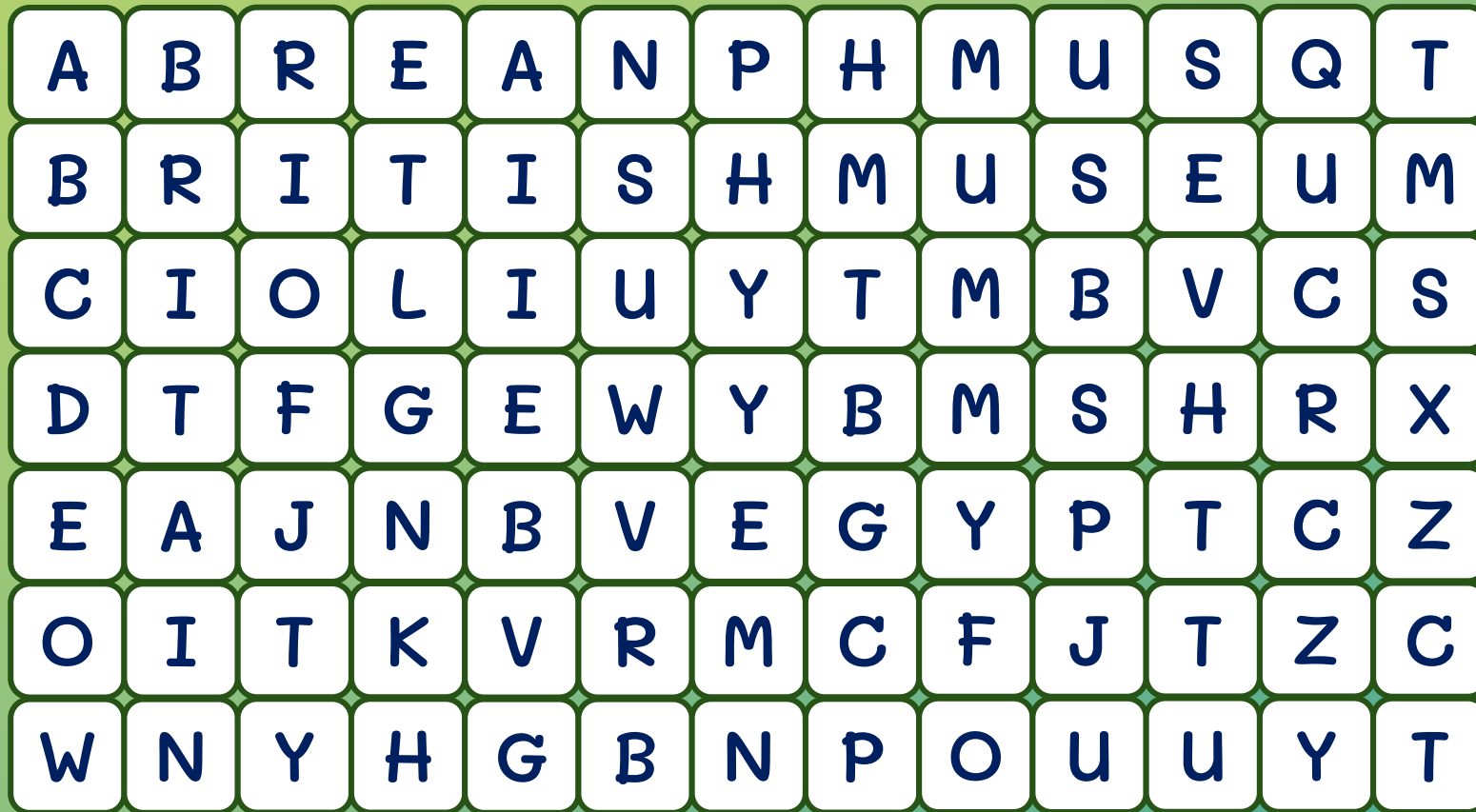

Wh-questions in simple past

Questions with *What*

What did + person(s) + do...?

I visited Britain last summer.

(did what)

What did you do last summer?

More examples

What did he eat yesterday?

What did you hear just now?

Questions with *When*

When did + person(s) + do...?

I visited Britain last summer.

(when)

When did you visit Britain?

More examples

When did you eat breakfast?

When did you hear this?

Wh-questions in simple past

Questions with *How*

How did + person(s) + do...?

I went to Japan by airplane.

(how)

How did you go to Japan?

Questions with *Where*

Where did + person(s) + do...?

I went to Japan last summer.

(where)

Where did you go last summer?

More example

How did you make the cake?

How did Alice come to school?

More example

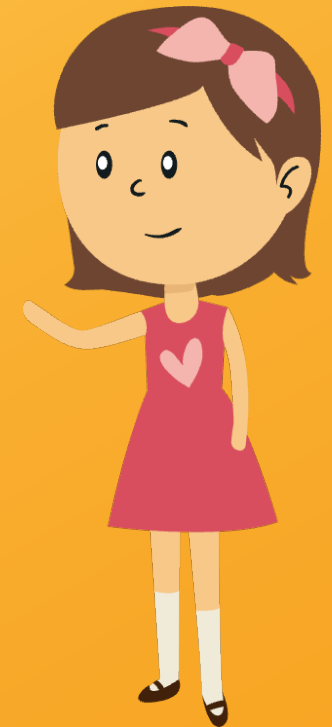
Where did they have the dinner?

Where did you find the book?

did + base form of verbs

What **did** you **do** last summer?
When **did** you **visit** Britain?
How **did** you **go** to Japan?
Where **did** you **go** last summer?

Note: We use the base form of verbs to go with "did" in sentences.

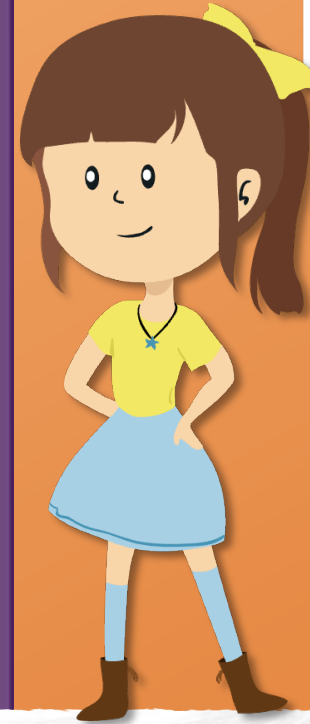
