# Present the Grammar

Look and read.



Will Lucy **go** scuba-diving this winter?



No, she **won't**.



Will you **go** snowboarding this winter?

Yes, I **will**. I **will go** snowboarding this winter. And Lucy **will go** rock-climbing this winter.



**person/ people + will + verb + a time in the future**

We use “will” to talk about something that will happen in the future, for example:

I **will go** snowboarding **this winter**.

Lucy **will go** rock-climbing **this winter**. (not “Lucy will goes...”)

*More expressions of time in the future:*

tomorrow

two days later

next summer

next week

next month

...

**will + person/ people + verb + a time in the future**

declarative sentence

Lucy **will** go rock climbing this winter.

question

**Will** Lucy go rock climbing this winter?

Yes, she will.

No, she won't.

*More examples*

Will Alice go scuba-diving next summer?

Will Sam go snowboarding tomorrow?

Will Annie go wind-surfing next Saturday?




