



## Present the Grammar

Questions with "How"

How long does it take to get from Beijing to Shanghai?



It takes five hours to get from Beijing to Shanghai.

How long ...? = How much time...?

- How long does it take to get from place A to place B?
- It takes... (time) to get from place A to place B.



How far ...? = How many meters/ kilometers/ miles away...?

- How far is it from place A to place B?
- It's ... (meters/kilometers/miles/...)

*Note:* 1 kilometer = 1,000 meters 1 mile = 1.61 kilometers

# Present the Grammar Questions with "How"



#### How many + plural nouns ...?

We use *How many...?* to ask about the number of things.

For example: How many backpacks do you have?

How many people are there?



#### How much is/ are ...?

When we want to know the price of something, we ask with *How much*.

For example: How much is the backpack?

How much are the books?

*Note:* We also use *how much* to ask about the amount of stuff.




