Present the Grammar

Look and read.

Would you like some spaghetti?

No, I wouldn't like any, thanks.

What would you like?

I'd like some salmon.

What would you like to drink?

I'd like to have some soda pop.

Present the Grammar

I'd like (to)...

I'd like + noun

I'd like some salmon.



= I want some salmon.

I'd like + to + verb + noun

I'd like to have some salmon.



= I want to have some salmon.



Note:

- I'd = I would
- It is more polite to use I'd like (to) ... instead of I want (to)...

Present the Grammar

Would you like (to)...?

General question: Would you like (to)...?

I'd like (to have) some salmon .

Would you like (to have) some salmon ?

Yes, I would like some.

No, I wouldn't like any.

Wh-question: What would you like (to)...?

I'd like (to have) some salmon .
(what)
