# Present the Grammar Modal Verb: must

positive





### somebody + must + do

e.g. We must return the books.

negative





somebody + mustn't + do

e.g. We mustn't throw litter on the ground.

*Note:* mustn't = must not

# Present the Grammar Modal Verb: Must

#### Yes-no questions with "must":

Must + somebody + do...?

e.g. Must I wear goggles for this experiment?

Yes, you **must**.

No, you needn't.

Note: In answering the question, we don't say "No, you mustn't." in a negative answer.


