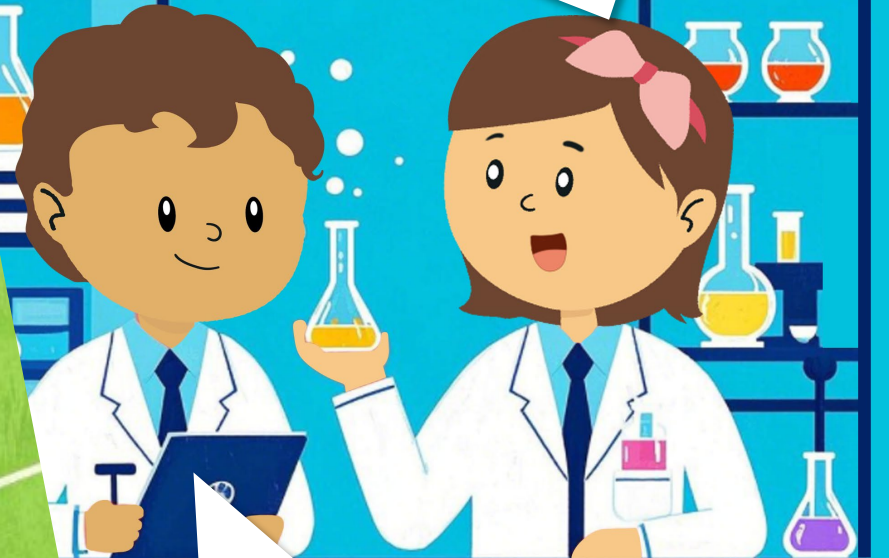
We **must return** the books to the library after we finish reading.



We **mustn't throw** litter on the ground.



Must I **wear** goggles for this experiment?



No, you **needn't**.

Present the Grammar

Modal Verb: must

positive



somebody + **must** + do

e.g. We **must** return the books.

negative



somebody + **mustn't** + do

e.g. We **mustn't** throw litter on the ground.

Note: mustn't = must not

Yes-no questions with “must”:

Must + somebody + do...?

e.g. **Must** I wear goggles for this experiment?

Yes, you **must**.

No, you **needn't**.

Note: In answering the question, we don't say “No, you mustn't.” in a negative answer.
