☆ Items starting with the Subject

If the sentence starts with the Subject, it is either a <u>statement</u> or a <u>tag question</u>.

E.g. Your office is very busy today. → Statement

The hotel <u>is</u> close to the airport, <u>isn't</u> <u>it</u>? \rightarrow Tag question

A tag question is a short question (e.g. is it? / isn't it?) that follows a statement and invites the hearer to respond to the statement. Negative tags expect a 'Yes' answer, positive a 'No' reply.

<u>affirmative</u> <u>negative</u> + <u>subject pronoun</u>

The hotel <u>isn't</u> close to the airport, <u>is it</u>?

<u>negative</u> <u>affirmative</u> + <u>subject pronoun</u>

As with yes/no questions, answers will usually begin with yes or no, but it may be omitted.
