Sentence structure

Sentence = a group of words that usually contains a subject (S) and a verb (V), and expresses a complete idea.

Subject = a noun, noun phrase, or pronoun that usually comes before a main verb and represents the person or

thing that performs the action of the verb, or about which something is stated.

Verb = a word or group of words that describes an action or state. A transitive verb has an object. An intransitive verb does not have an object.

Object =A Direct Object refers to the person or thing affected by the action of the verb. (He bought <u>a ball</u>.)

An Indirect Object usually refers to the person who 'benefits' from the action of the verb. (He bought <u>her</u> a ball.)

Complement =A Complement tells us something about the nature of the Subject or Object. (She is \underline{happy} . \Rightarrow S=C)

(He made her happy. \rightarrow O=C)

Modifier = a word or group of words that modifies another word or group.

N.B. 'Prep + Noun Group' and 'adverbs' are Modifiers. → (Put them in brackets)
