The city of Hastings is now under (mandatory) water (restrictions) (due to) the (drought). If you live in the Hastings city limits, here are your restrictions; You're ordered to do the following:

— (Repair) all (detectable) (leaks) within 72 hours.

— Limit outdoor (irrigation) use:

A. (Residential) gardens and (lawns)

You can water manually between 6am and 8pm on (alternate) days.*

You can use automatic watering systems only between midnight and 4am on alternate days.

B. Vehicle washing

A hand-held hose fitted with a (nozzle) can be used to pre-rinse and rinse only.

C. Pools and spas
