## Language Focus

### Demonstratives: This/These That/Those

We use "this" (for singular and uncountable nouns) and "these" (for plural nouns).  
When we refer to things that are far from us, we use "that" (for singular and uncountable nouns) and "those" (for plural nouns).

I love **this** dress!  
"What about **that** one over there?"  
"Do you like **these** shoes?"  
"Actually, I prefer **those** ones in the window."
