Fire as a Metaphor for Love

Fire is perhaps the best metaphor for love or romantic relationship because of its characteristics and types that are also used to describe love.

- Fires start with a flicker, a very tiny hot spark that ignites or kindles the flame.
- Fires can also smolder, that is, they burn slowly without any flame. This usually happens when a fire is covered by a lot of material (like leaves), which causes it to die down a little. But if you stir up the leaves, the fire will again flare up and rekindle.
- A blaze is a large fire that burns very hotly and often uncontrollably.
