Part 3 Distractors

There are two basic types of distractors for Part 3 items:

1. Repeated Words

This type of distractor uses words, phrases, and ideas that are mentioned in the conversation but changes them so that they are not true.

2. Not Mentioned

This type of distractor uses words, phrases, and ideas that are not mentioned in the conversation. There is no connection to the language used in the conversation.
